

Staffing for 2025-2026 School Year:

I know that it is difficult to believe that we are already beginning to look ahead at our student enrollment and staffing for next year.

It is very important that we have accurate numbers so that we hire the correct number of teachers. If you, or anyone you know, have <u>not yet registered</u> their child for school next year, or if you know that your child or children will not be attending Basinview in the fall, please let us know by calling the school at 902-832-8450. Please note, if you have moved out of our catchment area, you will need to register your child in the catchment area in which you live. If you do not live in area, you will have to follow the Out of Area request process.

Basinview Leaving "X" (formerly Twitter)

You may have heard that the HRCE has made a change in our approach to X, and effective April 1, HRCE (@HRCE_NS) will no longer post on the platform. So too, has Basinview (@Basinview Drive)

Why is HRCE leaving X?

- Concerns about platform changes: Recent changes to X's terms of service and policies have led to uncertainty and dissatisfaction among users.
- Security and privacy issues: Accounts on X can be vulnerable to hacking, spam, and other security threats.
- Negative impact on staff and school communities: The prevalence of abusive behaviour and misinformation on X can cause harm.

While many are choosing to join alternatives to X, for now our school has not decided on a social media platform. As always, families will receive all important and information from our school and from HRCE through our website (bvc.hrce.ca) phone, and email.
